

# Financial Aid

Ox-Bow offers a variety of scholarships for students taking credit or non-credit classes. Application procedures and requirements are described below. As most scholarship deadlines fall before class registration starts, students who are awarded scholarships are responsible for registering for Ox-Bow classes. Students may submit *one set* of application materials to apply for The Baron, Liebert, Zanzi, Merit, Fursman, Uretz, Brandess, Balbo/DeGraaf and Daniel Johnson Scholarships, as well as the Ox-Bow Fellowship. The Pre-College, Grellner, Tews, Metternich, Barna, Smith, West Michigan, and Bob & Genevieve Johnson Scholarships all require *separate* applications and materials. All scholarships are partial scholarships and vary in award amount.

## WORK SCHOLARSHIPS

### NO DEADLINE

For any student taking an Ox-Bow course. Credit and non-credit courses. Apply at time of class registration; first-come, first-served. Work Scholarships are not available to students enrolled in glass courses or the Pre-College Program.

Work scholarships are awarded by Ox-Bow on a first-come, first-served basis, and there are a limited number of scholarship positions available per week. Work scholarship students receive an award in exchange for working approximately 15 hours per week during their class session at Ox-Bow. Duties include housekeeping, building and grounds maintenance, and dishwashing. Award amounts are listed under Tuition and Fees.

The functioning of Ox-Bow depends on the support of work scholarship students. It is absolutely required that students inform Ox-Bow in advance if they decide not to complete work scholarship duties. Students may cancel their Work Scholarship awards up to the Monday three weeks before the start of their class.

Interested students should apply at the time of registration for classes indicating interest on the Registration Form.

## SAIC FINANCIAL AID

For SAIC undergraduate and graduate students. Credit courses only.

Please contact the SAIC Financial Aid Office for deadlines. Undergraduate and graduate students from the School of the Art Institute of Chicago may be able to use their financial aid award from SAIC toward credit tuition for courses at Ox-Bow. Financial aid typically does not cover room & board or lab fees at Ox-Bow.

For degree-seeking student from any college or university with demonstrated financial need, who would be unable to attend Ox-Bow without the support of this scholarship. Credit courses only.

For undergraduate and graduate students from the School of the Art Institute of Chicago. Credit or non-credit courses.

For undergraduate and graduate students currently enrolled in SAIC's Painting and Drawing Programs. Credit or non-credit courses.

**MERIT SCHOLARSHIP****DEADLINE:** *Friday, March 5, 2010.*

For SAIC undergraduate and graduate students. Credit or non-credit courses.

**LALLA ANNE CRITZ ZANZI SCHOLARSHIP****DEADLINE:** *Friday, March 5, 2010.*

For female SAIC undergraduate and graduate painting students only. Credit courses only.

**GRACE AND WALTER BYRON SMITH SCHOLARSHIP****NO DEADLINE**

For any student who has attended a Catholic college or parochial high school in the state of Illinois for at least one full year. This is a need-based scholarship. Credit courses only.
